



Demography of registered Syrian refugees




In-camp demography

of the households reported loss of job and entire income due to the pandemic in some countries





** Data includes only those verified by UNHCR, General Security reported additional figures from their Group Returns and of these a total of 158 individuals were not known to UNHCR.






Regional Return Trends: 2018-2020




Regional Monthly Average

Returns by Sex & Age in 2020






