




Registered Syrian Refugees in Host Countries

Key figures



70%

of people in need in the region are women or children



95%

of Syrian refugees across the region reside within the host community, mainly in urban areas; 5 % reside in camps



Some 35%

of children are out of school while over 20% of children cannot continue education through distance learning

of the households reported loss of job and entire income due to the pandemic in some countries



Voluntary Syrian Refugee Returns as Verified by UNHCR as of 31 December 2020




*The numbers reported are only those verified or monitored by UNHCR and do not reflect the entire number of returns, which may be significantly higher.


**Data includes only those verified by UNHCR, General Security reported additional figures from their Group Returns and of these a total of 158 individuals were not known to UNHCR.






