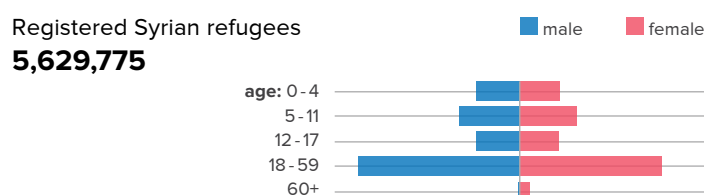


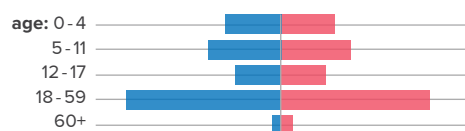

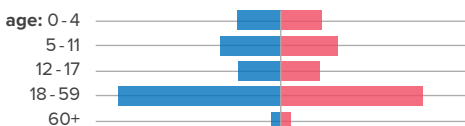
## Demography of registered Syrian refugees

## Key figures

**66.3%**  
of people in need in the region are women or children

**95%**  
of Syrian refugees across the region reside within the host community, mainly in urban areas; 5 % reside in camps

**Some 35%**  
of children are out of school and a significant number of children are missing out on distance learning opportunities

In 2020, **over 60%** of the households reported loss of job and entire income due to the pandemic in some countries

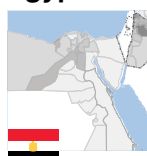

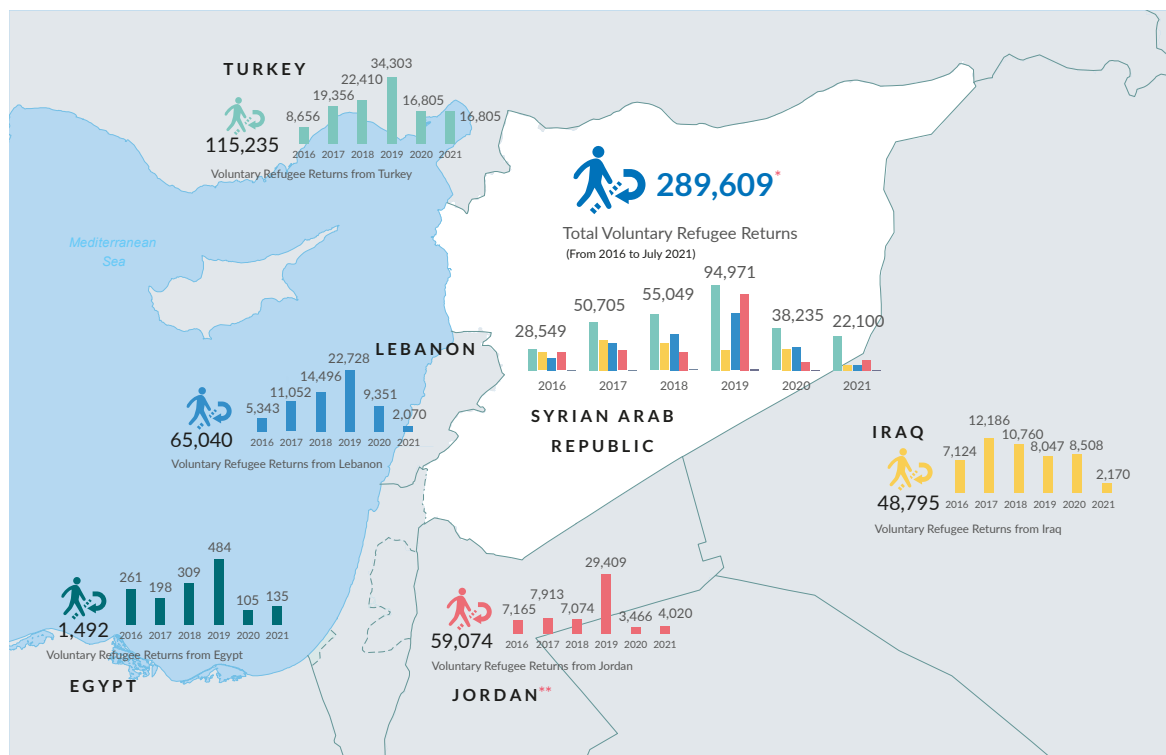

\* The numbers reported are only those verified or monitored by UNHCR and do not reflect the entire number of returns, which may be significantly higher.

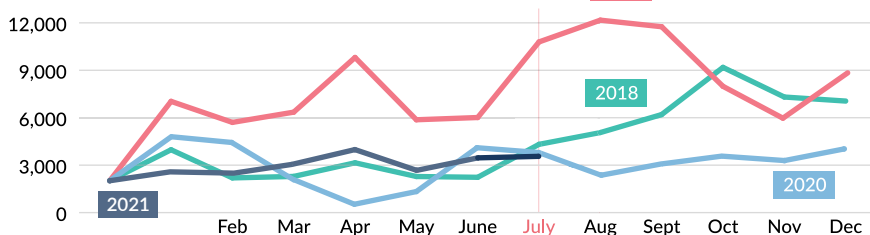

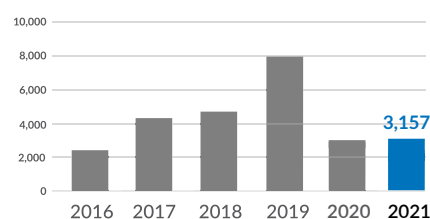

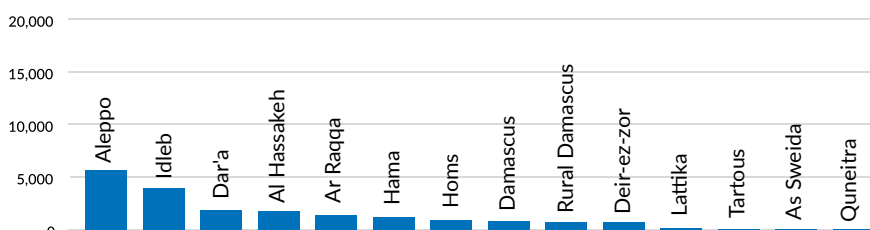
### Regional Return Trends: 2018-2021



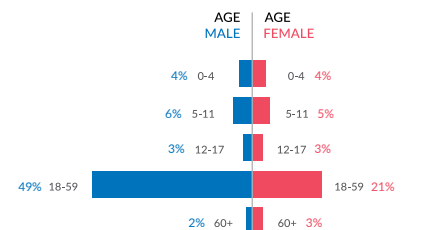
### Regional Monthly Average

### Returns by Sex & Age in 2021

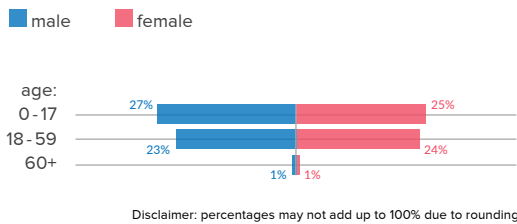

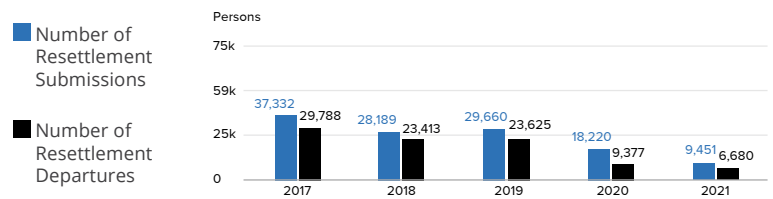

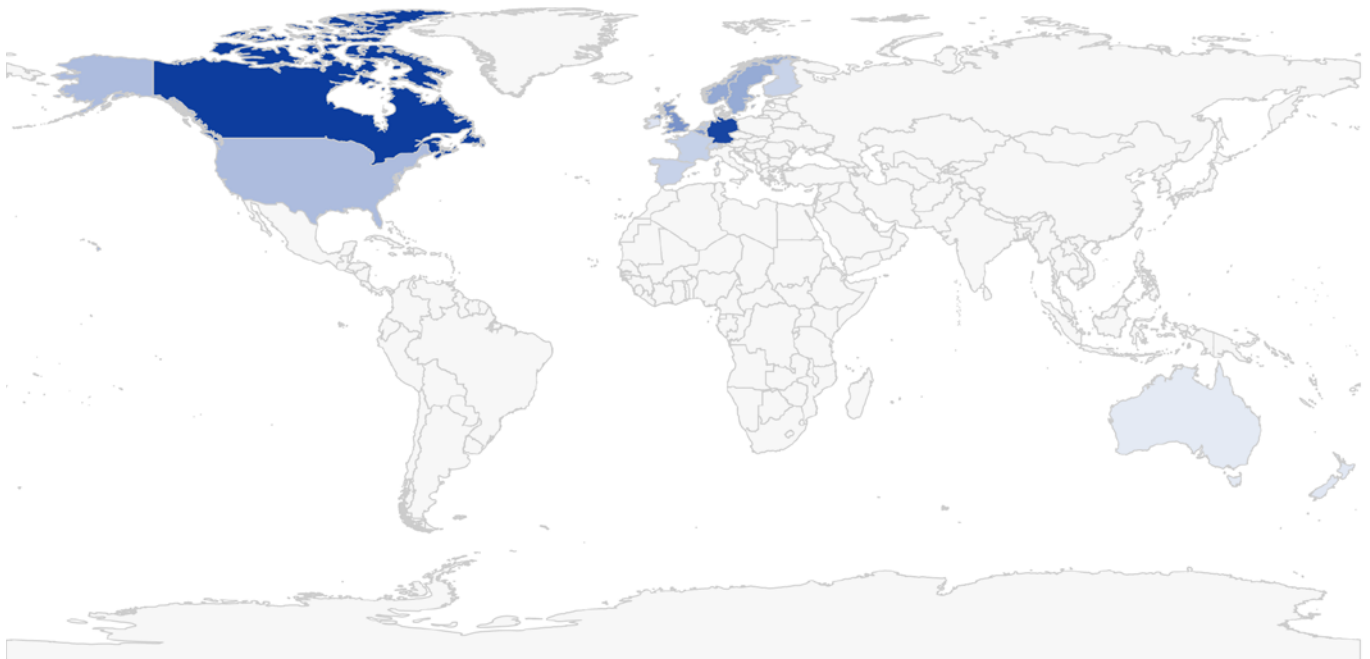
