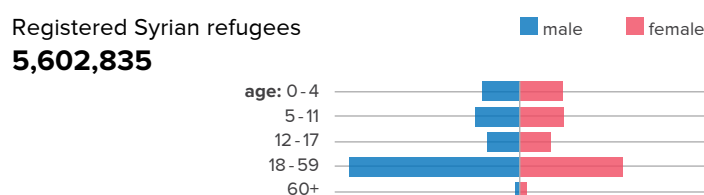


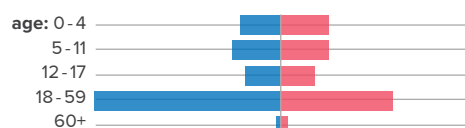

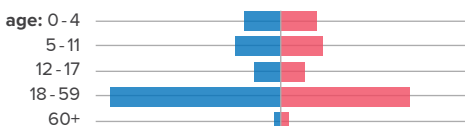
Demography of registered Syrian refugees

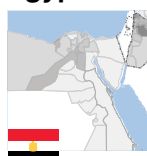

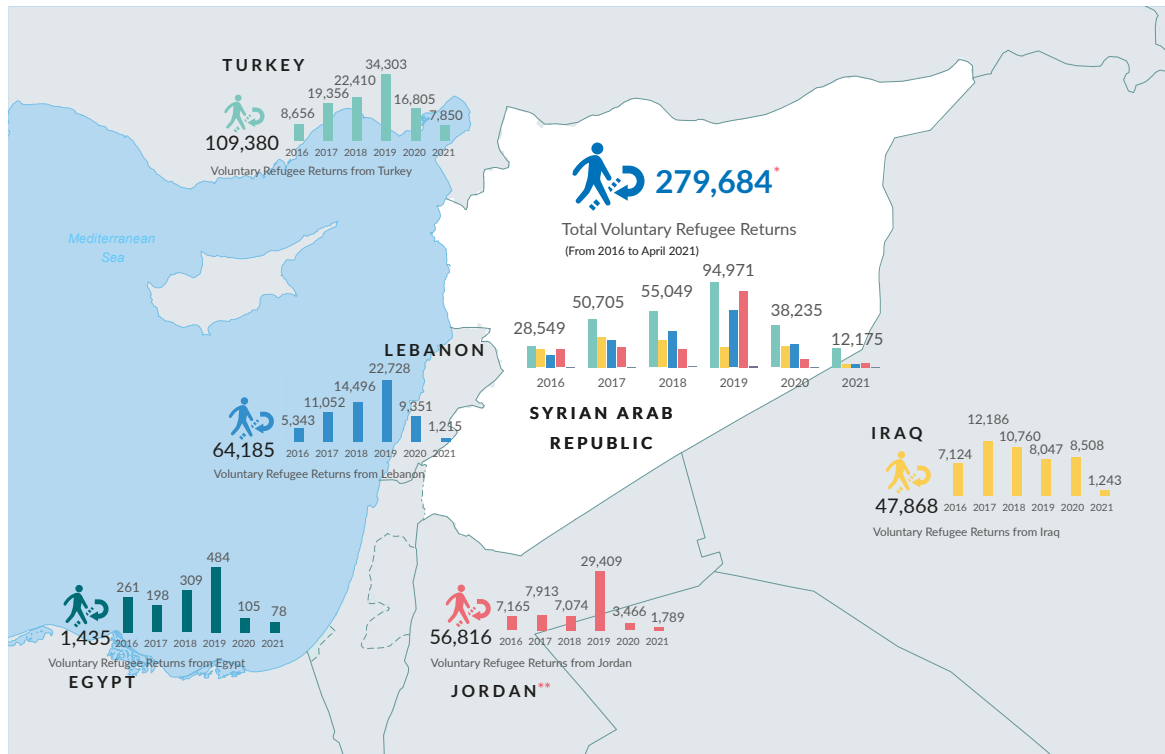

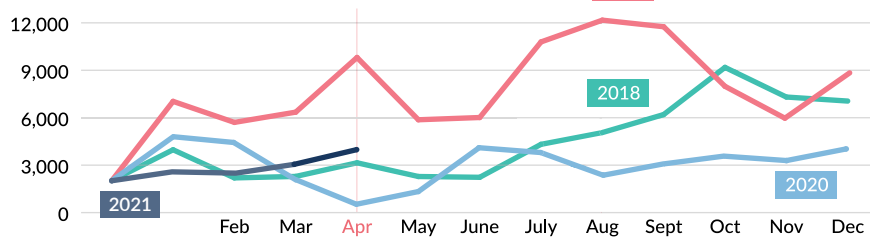

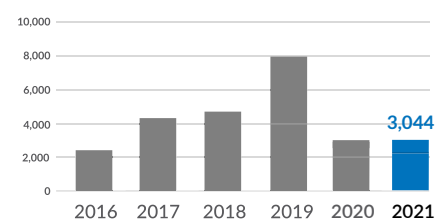

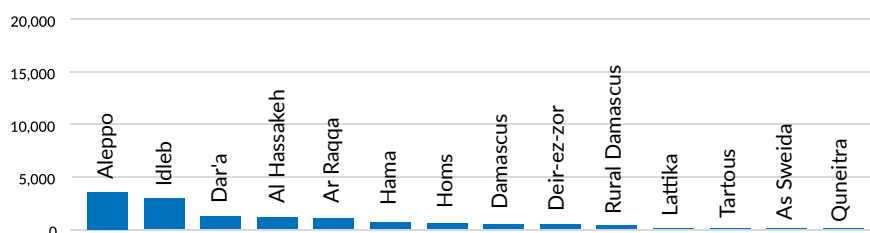
Regional Return Trends: 2018-2021



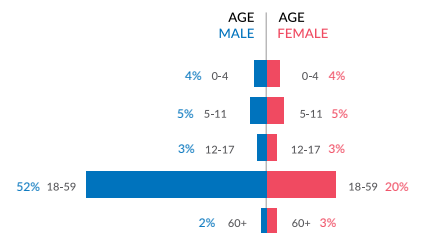
Regional Monthly Average

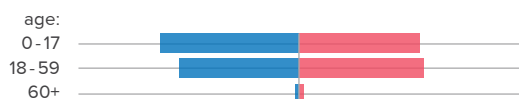

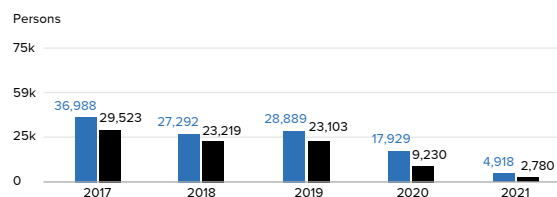

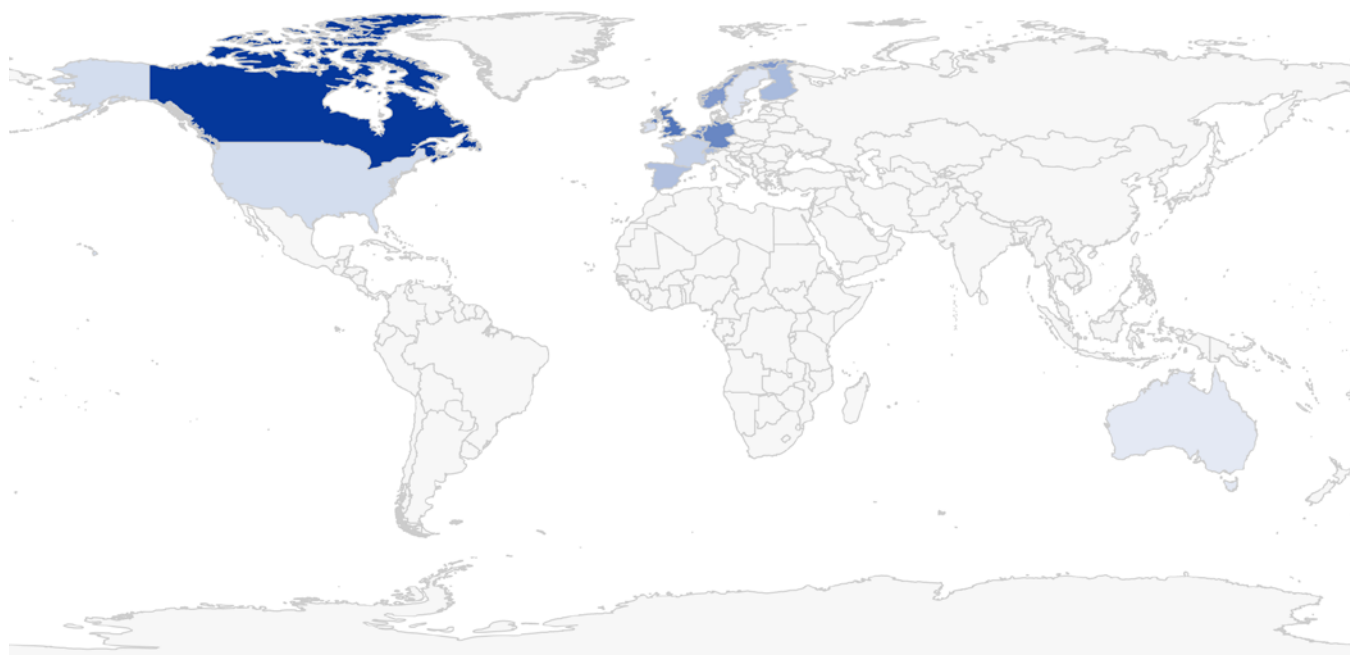


Resettlement Submissions and Departures 2017 - 2021
