




Registered Syrian Refugees in Host Countries

66.3%

of people in need in the region are women or children



Voluntary Syrian Refugee Returns as Verified by UNHCR as of 31 October 2021








Daily return average in 2021 **101**


Monthly return average in 2021 **3,056**




