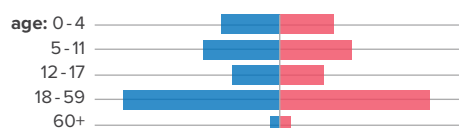

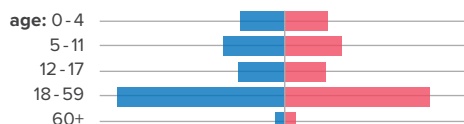

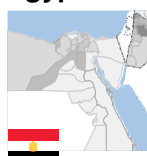

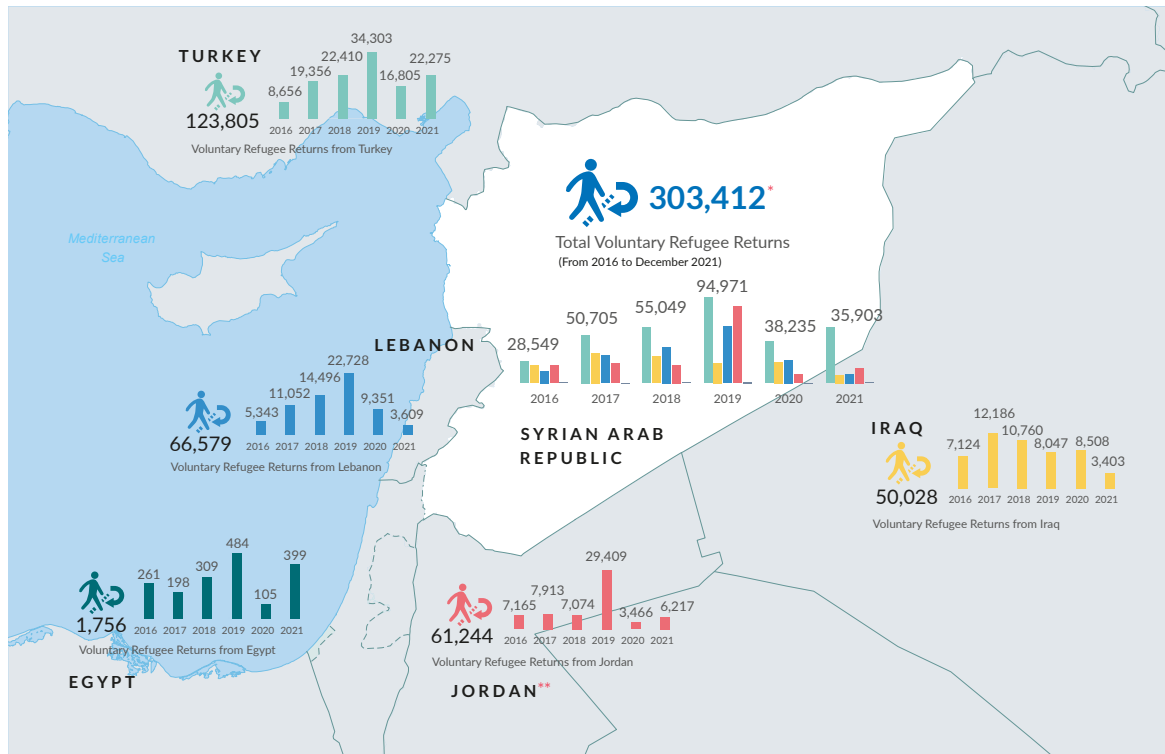

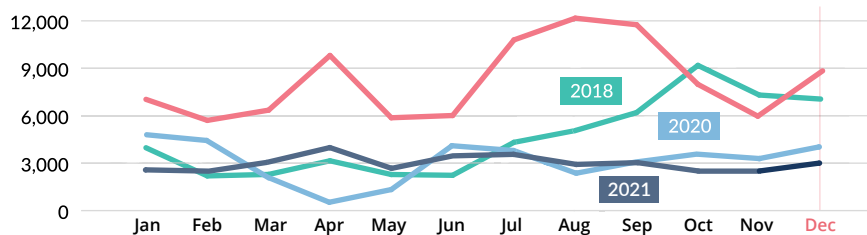

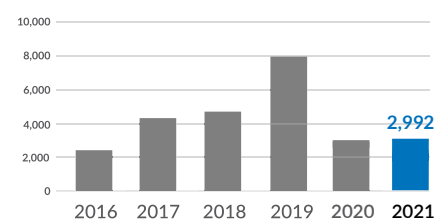

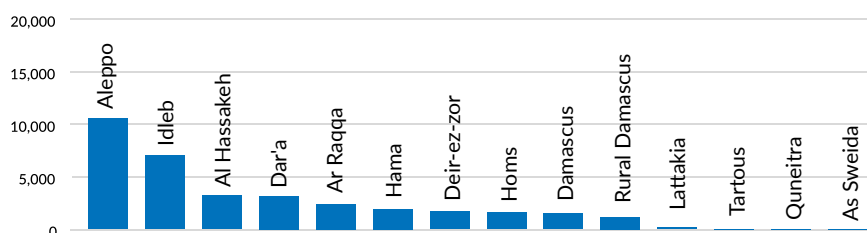
Regional Return Trends: 2018-2021



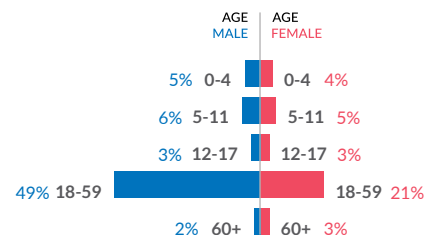
Regional Monthly Average

Returns by Sex & Age in 2021



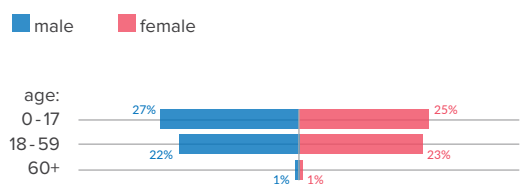

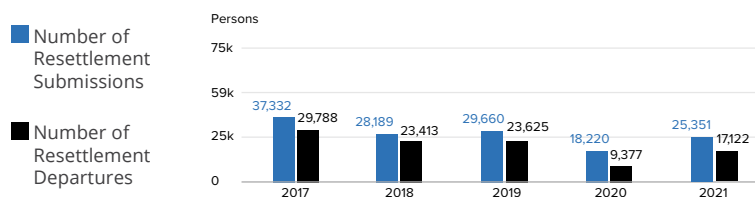

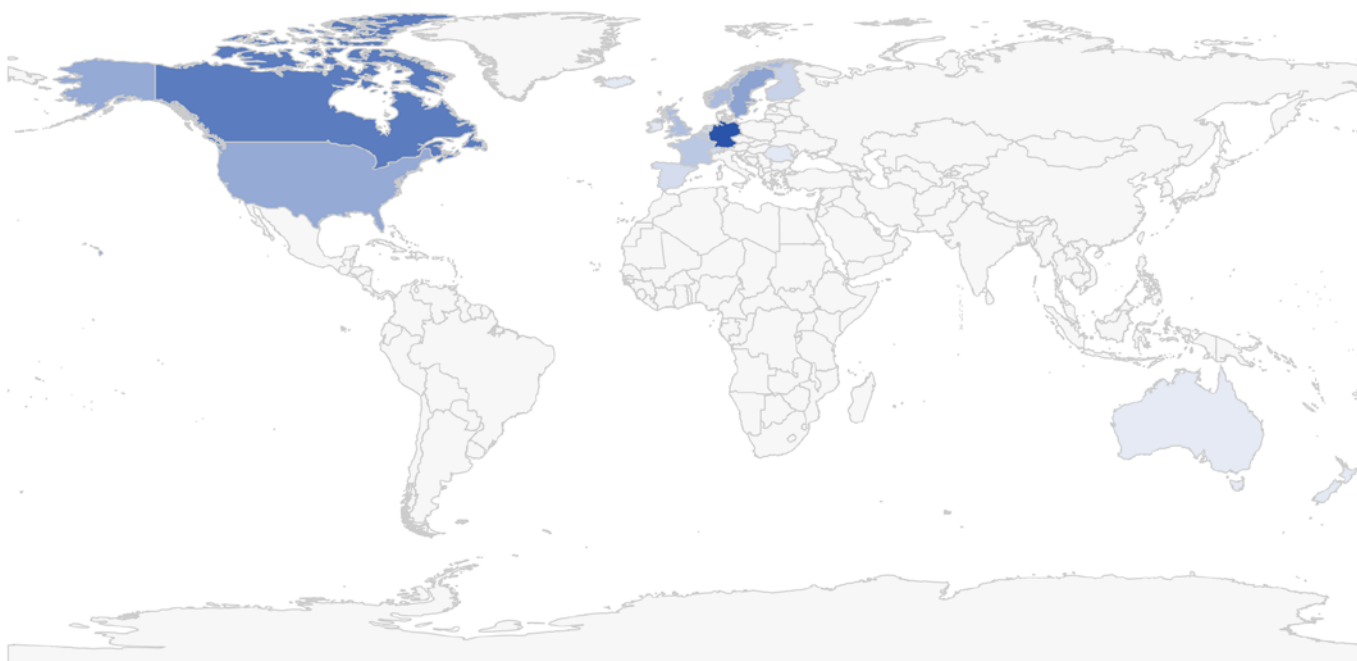
