





of the registered Syrian refugees are children under the age of 18.



95%

of Syrian refugees across the region reside within the host community, mainly in urban areas; **5%** reside in camps



Syrian refugee youth aged between 15 and 24 years old constitute around **20%** of the total registered Syrian population in the five countries.



9% of individuals were found to have a disability in Lebanon, **30%** with physical or intellectual needs in Jordan, and **8%** of Syrian refugees are considered to have disability in Egypt.












Regional Return Trends: 2019-2022




Regional Monthly Average






