ABOUT THE 3RP

What is the Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan?

The 3RP is a strategic, coordination, planning, advocacy, fundraising, and programming platform for humanitarian and development partners to respond to the Syria crisis. It comprises one regional plan, with five standalone country chapters covering Turkey, Lebanon, Jordan, Iraq, and Egypt.

Who is the 3RP?

The Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan is a platform which consists of over 160 implementing partners. You can find the list of implementing partners <u>here</u>.

Who is leading the 3RP?

The 3RP is co-lead by UNHCR and UNDP.

Why does the 3RP exist?

The Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan has been created in response to the Syria Crisis. Now into its seventh year, the 3RP has led the way in terms of the international community's support to national efforts to deal with the impact of the crisis. The 3RP has been at the forefront of many policy and programmatic innovations including support to national and local systems, using technology to increase efficiency and effectiveness, and supporting the self- reliance of refugees and host communities. Since when does the 3RP exist?

The 3RP has been launched in December 2014.

What happened before 2014?

The predecessor of the 3RP is the Regional Response Plan (RRP). The first RRP for Syrian refugees in Turkey, Lebanon, Jordan, Iraq and Egypt was launched in December 2012. (<u>Timeline</u>)

Whom does the plan target?

The plan targets Syrian refugees and vulnerable host community members.

How does the 3RP work as a mechanism?

Does the 3RP have several components?

The 3RP consists of two components, the refugee component and the resilience component.

What is the overarching frame for the 3RP?

It is to promote resilience for all, guided by the principle that 'no one is left behind'. From there, the regional strategic directions set the overall high-level parameters for the regional response and articulate the impact which 3RP partners strive to make.

How can promoting resilience for all / the principle of 'leaving no one behind' be achieved?

Four Strategic Directions have been identified which are focused on the impact the 3RP seeks to make against the immediate and longer-term needs. Those four strategic directions are:

- 1. Protecting People
- 2. Pursuing Durable Solutions
- 3. Supporting Dignified Lives
- 4. Enhancing National and Local Capacities

What are "Durable Solutions"? They are using the same branding and visuals as the 3RP.

Yes, Durable Solutions are located under the 3RP umbrella. Durable Solutions include the topics of return, and resettlement and complementary pathways.

PRIMARY COLOR:

Olive Green The main colour of the 3RP is a dark, olive green, representing resilience and hope.



SECONDARY COLOR:

Light Green
To emphatize on the two components of the 3RP, a secondary color, a light yellowish green, is introduced.







SUPPORTIVE COLORS:

Red, White, Dark Gray To create contrast visually, red is used as a supportive color. Additional supportive colors are white, and a neutral dark gray.



FONTS:

Open Sans Montserrat

Sans serif fonts: Clean esthetics; Appropriate in situations that require a direct approach

While serif fonts add personality and look better in larger sizes (print), sans-serif fonts work better for web. The 3RP focuses on digital comms products like digital publications and interactive content like dashboards. The content should be presented in a minimal, but modern way, while delivering information in a direct way.

CLEAN, DIRECT, MINIMALISTIC, & MODERN

Both Open Sans and Montserrat are open source fonts and can be used license-free

SHAPE:

The shape of the visual is consistent with the shape of the originally designed logo, provided by UNDP in 20xx.

The visual depicts two cubes, connected with and in each other.

Meaning: Refugee and resilience component being connected and entwined.

HUMAN-CENTERED

The 3RP is a platform for humanitarian and development partners. Our approach is **human-centered**, focusing on both individuals and groups.

COLLABORATIVE

Effective collaboration is a necessity.

The 3RP is showing collaboration with a variety of international and national partners, between sectors, and with governmental entities.

INCLUSIVE

Our principle is 'no one is left behind'.

The 3RP is inclusive, consisting of the efforts of multiple implementing partners, and sectors, while collaborating with a variety of governmental counterparts. The plan itself does target both Syrian refugees, as well as vulnerable host community members of the host countries Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, and Turkey.

ABOUT THE RDSWG

Durable Solutions is located under the 3RP umbrella.

Durable solutions for refugees from Syria are based on a comprehensive protection and solutions strategy which seeks to: i) support host country and community resilience; ii) enable refugee self-reliance, including access to services, legal work opportunities and livelihoods; iii) expand access to resettlement in third countries and other complementary pathways, and; iv) plan for the return of refugees to Syria, on a voluntary basis, when conditions for a safe, dignified and sustainable return are in place.


